

University of Wisconsin Fees for Industry-Sponsored Studies

Effective Date: February 1, 2022

UW-Madison no longer charges IRB fees except as described in the table below. Please note:

- Effective December 1, 2019, all fully-industry sponsored studies must be reviewed by an independent IRB
- UW-Madison will not charge IRB fees when serving as the reviewing or single IRB for multisite studies.
- When UW-Madison cedes review to another institution (e.g., university), that institution may charge UW-Madison researchers for that review. The Reliance and Navigation Team (irbreliance@wisc.edu) can assist study teams in determining whether another institution may charge for IRB review.
- Independent IRBs have their own fee schedules and payment of those fees is managed by the sponsor, independent IRB, and UW Study team. For **non-industry sponsored** studies using a **commercial IRB**, WCG is the preferred contract vendor for IRB services.
